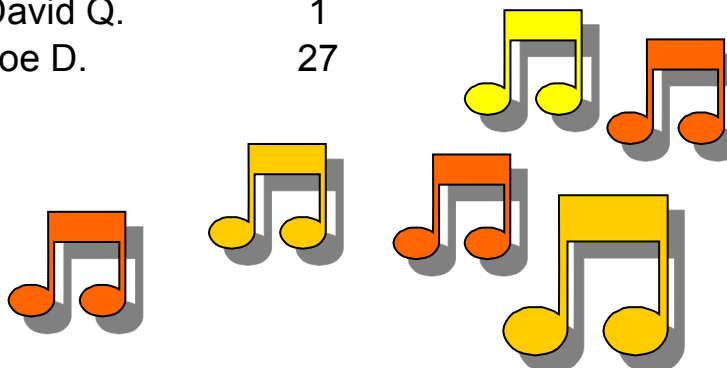

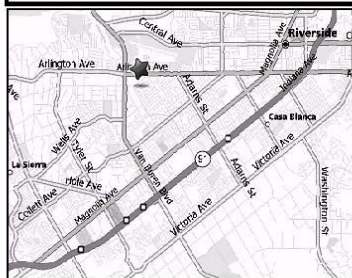



Do the “**Clamors of the World**” have you stagnant, are you restless and think that sobriety is boring?

Hospitals & Institutions and Public Information could use You, You and You.

These are committee’s within the structure of Alcoholics Anonymous through our Central Office. Public Information attends health fairs, college, high schools and we are requested at medical, police and community forums to carry a message of what AA is, does and doesn’t do. John heads up P.I for years now because of the low participation by our fellow AA members, no one else will step up to the plate. Yes, newer members can be of great assistance in our efforts to carry the message to those wondering what recovery is all about. However, Public Information needs all members willing to help regardless of so called “TIME”. The committee meets on the first Saturday of every month at Central Office at 11:00 a.m. John’s phone is 909-648-2984 and he could really use some support.

Hospital & Institutions also is people poor with volunteers. We meet at the Unity Club on 1307 Brookside, Redlands, Ca 92373 at 3 p.m. on the 3rd Sunday of every month. Going to regular meetings is great however I ask myself “What can I do for those who still suffer and AA as a whole”. More important is that “**one more bright idea**” and we could be the man or woman that is in that facility.

Example; Becky, Carol and Nancy go into the various woman’s jail facilities and always need help. San Bernardino and Riverside corrections can be a real drawn-out clearance process with extra effort on our part to prepare paperwork but the effort is well rewarded in Spirit. There is Glen Helen, West Valley, Robert Presley, Banning and California Intuition for Women (CIW). All these panels always need help. There are many panels’ that don’t have such stringent clearance requirements such as Job Corps, His House, and Salvation Army. Psychiatric Hospitals such as Riverside Health Care, Shandin Hills and Riverside Psychiatric Treatment Facility. The Riverside facility is currently dark because of lack of commitment, what a travesty. Many of these panels only go into facility every other week or even once a month. Not enough help, how about Gibson House, Whiteside Manor (women) and Cedar House. Requirement is minimal sobriety with a fire for sobriety. Patton State Hospital, for the insane, is barely being held together. The clearance requirement here is only 1 year sober, fingerprint and TB test.... That’s duck soup easy.

In Conclusion, if you’re from Chino, Riverside, Rancho Cucamonga, Banning, Hemet, mountains or San Bernardino area there is a great need for your participation. We need the newer, medium and older AA members to become involved and any help is appreciated by those who are locked up and looking for the way out.

Our Central Office needs volunteers and many groups do not have an Intergroup Representative, not to mention keeping our 12 step call list up to date. Service is a big part of our triangle to sobriety, so let’s do the right thing to keep this God given Gift intact for all bewildered who come to our doors, possibly our children or grandchildren.

So, God doesn’t want our availability He want’s our availability. Please come and join us.

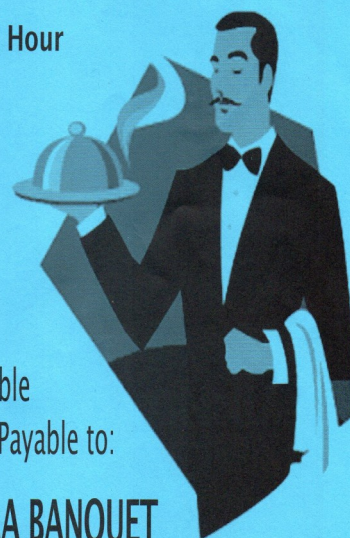
