From the Inland Empire Hospitals and Institutions Committee regarding status of the overall financial posture of the Group.

During the Pandemic from January of 2020 through June of 2022 our Literature Account grew from approximately \$3,500 to \$13,500 due to the ongoing generosity of the local groups and individuals continuing to provide contributions from their 7th Tradition collections.
